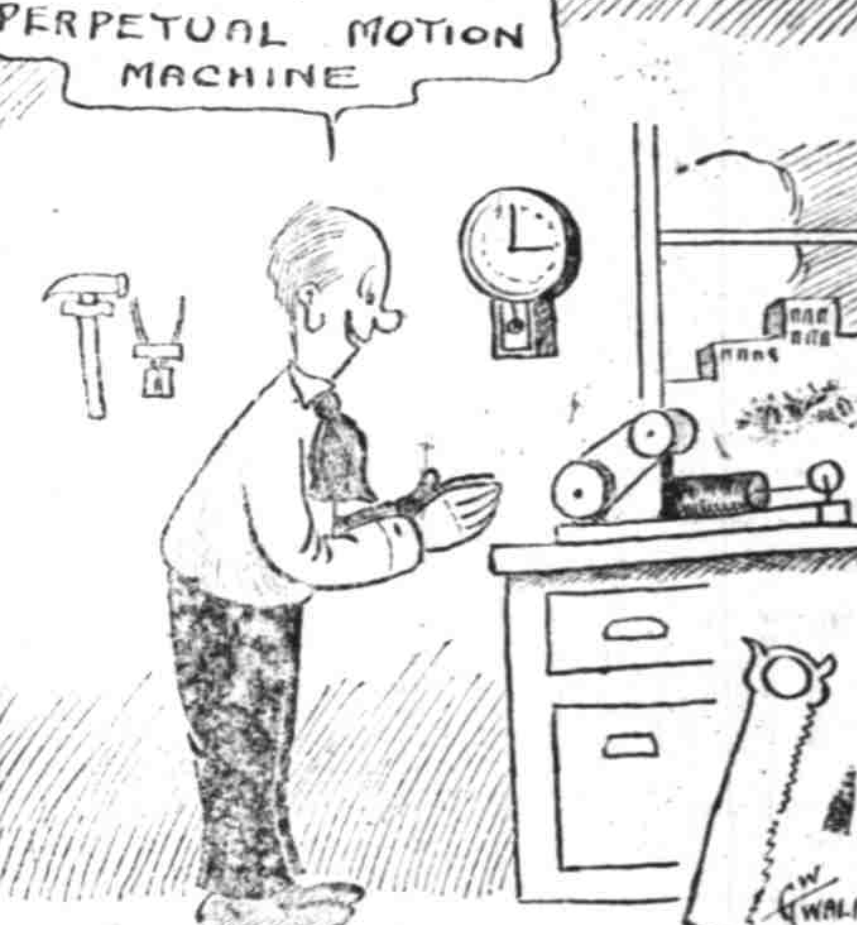

Dr. Cottrell said, although the de-
vices are of practically no use in
the average mine disaster.

Reviewing a number of cases
recently where men attempting
mine rescue work with army type
gas masks had been overcome and
had died, Dr. Cottrell said:

"These fatalities illustrate the
futility of the belief quite preva-
lent throughout the country that
this army type of gas mask will
protect the wearer against any
type of gases under all conditions.
The fact is that the army gas
mask was a very excellent device
for the purpose intended, that of
protecting our soldiers from the
diabolical gases used in warfare.
These men, it would seem, do not
realize that out in the open air
of the battlefield the percentage
of gas in the air would not be
nearly so large as in the confined
spaces of a mine or factory."

The army mask affords abso-
lutely no protection against car-

bon monoxide gas, which is most
prevalent in mine fires and in
factory disasters. Dr. Cottrell said,
adding that the masks will actu-
ally be a menace because of the
false feeling of security they give
the wearer.

The bureau of mines endorses
the use of the self-contained oxy-
gen mine rescue breathing ap-
paratus and is prepared to furn-
ish information regarding its use.
