

Comptroller Reports Loans and Discounts In Month

WASHINGTON, Feb. 22 Loans and discounts, excepting rediscounts, of the national backs outside of New York City, 4 creased \$265,260,00 between Nov 15 and Dec. 29, Comptroller Wiliams of the treasury announced tonight in making known the results of the bank call of the les ter date. In New York loans increased \$49,041,009.

Savings bank deposits increased in that period, the comptroller reported, although other hank usdecreased. Capital, purposits plus and profits also increased to \$2,787.941,000, which he said was the highest amount ever teported.

Net reduction of loans, aller-ing for the increase in New York, totalled \$21,367,799,000, a redge tion of \$714,114,000 since Nos Total deposits were \$16,277, 757,000, a reduction of \$683,545.

Capital was reported at \$1.172. 291,000, an increase of \$2,361 Surplus and undivided profits of the banks amounts \$1,515,650,000, which shows as increase of \$15,327,000. The number of banks reports was 8,130, an increase of 240 or er December, 1919.
