WINNERS

Some wonderfully clever as well as original solutions to the Statesman Business Chart, have been handed in during the past week, and the judges regret that they have but five prizes to award. However, the best that can be done is to award the five prizes to the most deserving and give complimentary mention to the other clever solutions.

The capital prize, \$5, is awarded to Fred Kruger, 2540 Leeson street, whose solution was made as follows: The chart of the city was mounted on the center of a heavy piece of cardboard and around it were grouped 12 houses, made of paper—these houses representing the places of business of the 12 advertisers whose phone numbers were involved in the contest. On the roof of each of these paper houses was pasted the advertisement of one of the 12 advertisers. From each of these houses a thread was extended to the exact location of that particular advertiser's place of business on the chart of Salem's business district. This solution entailed considerable amount of work. It is absolutely being fastened to the original and original and is fairly accurate.

The second prize, \$2, is awarded Mrs. H. M. Buell, route 1, Salem, and her solution runs a close second to the one described above. At the top of the page a rainbow is drawn in colors, and inside the rainbow the following verse is carefully penned: "A penny saved is one earned. Indeed; the Statesman's chart will be your guide."

In carrying out the rainbow idea, Mrs. Buell has bent with in the form of a rainbow one end of each wire being fastened to the advertiser's phone number; the other to the location of his place of business on the chart of Salem's business section. The judges are impelled to compliment Mrs. Buell. Her solution is clever, original and reasonably accurate.

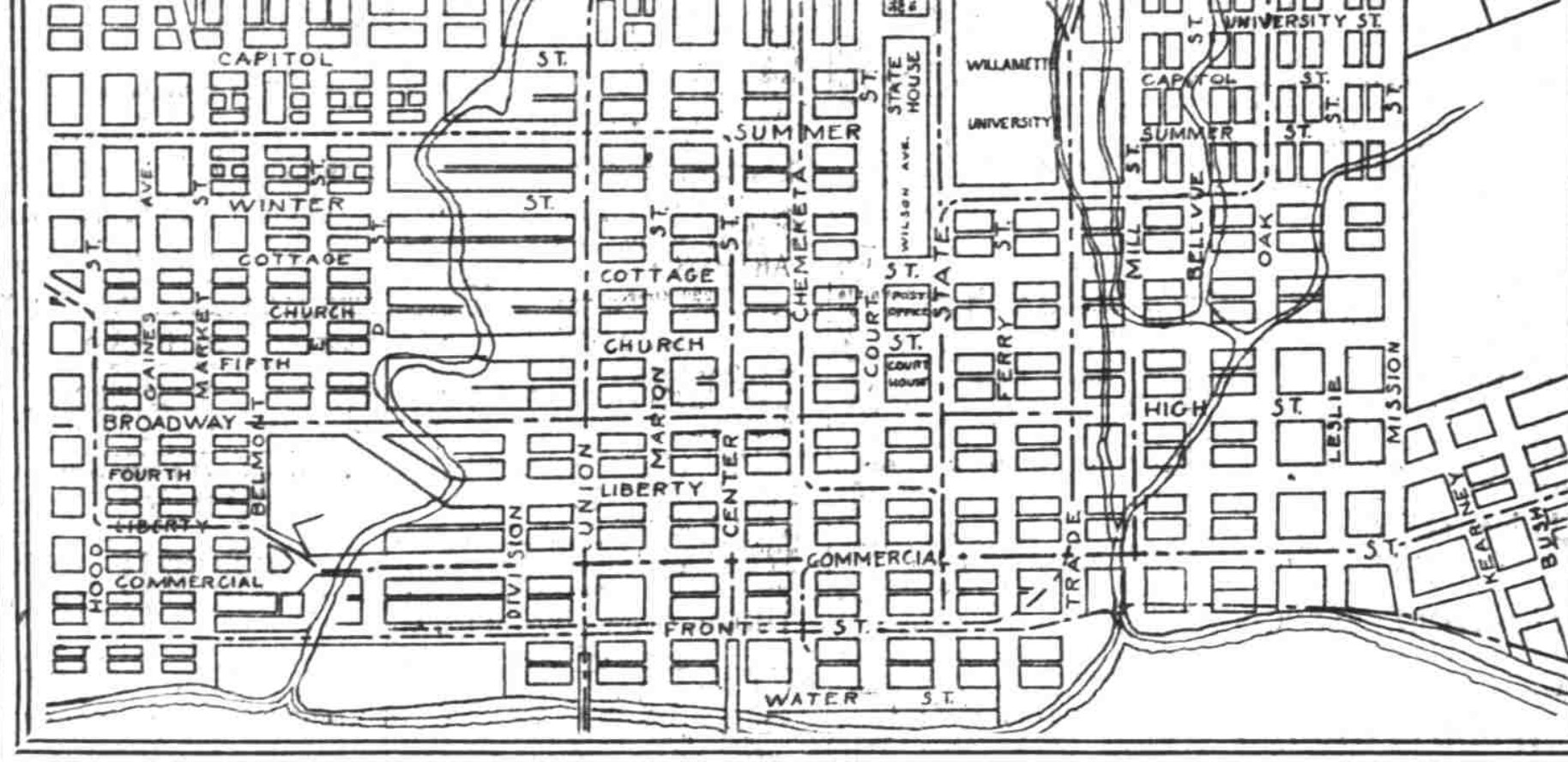
