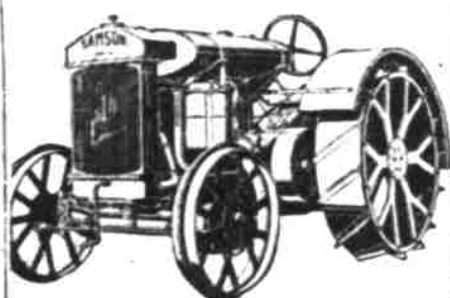

- Here are ten good reasons why a silo should be on every farm where livestock is kept: 1. The silo preserves the palatability and succulence of green crops for winter feeding. 2. It conserves the entire crop. 3. The silo increases the livestock capacity of the farm. 4. Silage can be fed in summer when pastures are short. 5. Silage is relished by dairy and beef cattle and sheep. 6. It is digestible and aids in the digestion of other feeds fed with it. 7. Silage reduces the cost of production of milk, beef and mutton. 8. It will increase the milk flow. 9. Silage promotes the health of the herd. 10. The silo provides an economical method for the storage of roughage.

Salem District Should Diversify in Vegetables

In the fruit industry, the Salem district is the land of diversity— And it should be the land of diversity in vegetable growing. Many of the vegetables do especially well on almost any kind of land here—and others do exceptionally well on soils especially adapted to their production. On our warm sandy river bottom soils there can be raised good sorghum, and sorghum ought to be raised here, and there should be a factory in Salem making sorghum syrup. This is in the interest of the self-sufficiency to which we should aspire. The recent discovery that the vitamins in tomatoes are not injured at all by canning will without doubt enormously increase the world's consumption of tomatoes. Our farmers can raise good tomatoes, and lots of them, on their warm, sandy soils. They should raise more tomatoes. Some of our gardeners ought to specialize on mushrooms; and more of them on horseradish, rhubarb and garlic; first making marketing arrangements in advance. The highest possible uses should be made of all our lands, and there should be more and more specializing. We should do the things we can do best; and especially produce the things we can produce better than other districts. Cabbage is the Salem Slogan subject for next week, and another special crop or two will likely be included.

DID YOU KNOW That the Salem district should grow its own sorghum to make its own syrup; that more tomatoes ought to be grown here, on the land especially adapted to their production; that our dairymen and gardeners ought to raise more kale, which produces great crops here; that some of our farmers and gardeners ought to specialize on rhubarb, horseradish, garlic, etc., and that in doing these things in the way of specialized crops for special markets permanent industries will be established here that will add to the sum of general prosperity and attract farmers and gardeners of the higher classes to the Salem district; that in fruit growing we have the land of diversity, and that we may have also the land of diversity in vegetable growing?
