Breeder's Have Produced 25 Out of 80 of the Beauties in the High Merit Classes of the Breed, or 31 Per Cent of the Total; and It Has Been Estimated That This State Has Only About Six Per Cent of All the Pure Bred Jersey Cows in the United States.

News was given in the Statesman of Thursday morning of the test world record Jersey cow, owned by Ashwood, belonging to C. Arthur & Stauff of Rickreall, beautiful Norens of Ashwood produced 113.26 pounds of butterfat May, and she beat the cow of Connecticut that had the world record before by a good lead. The excellent cow produced 110.76 pounds of butterfat in one month. Oregon is in the lead.

Way of determining the production of the cows. If a cow produces a given amount she is admitted to the "Register of Merit." The minimum requirement for a cow that enters test at two years or less of age is 250.5 pounds of fat. For each additional day of the cow is over two years old, one-tenth of one pound shall be added to the initial requirement; and this increase shall apply until the age of five years is reached, when the required yield will have become 260 lbs.
