Van Winklé is Queried By Corporation Official Two questions considered of public importance, relative to the sales of stock by corporations, have been placed before Attorney General Van Winklé by T. B. Handley, state corporation commissioner. The attorney returned his answer Saturday. The questions are: "1. Is a corporation, engaged in selling directly to subscribers and on the installment plan its own unsubscribed, or fully paid and non-assessable treasury stock, a dealer within the meaning of section 6574, as amended by section 3, chapter 158, general laws of Oregon for 1921? "2. Is a corporation acting as fiscal or sales agent under the terms of a contract with a principal, which terms provide either for collection by the agent of the initial payment made by subscriber at times of taking subscription or collection of subsequent installments in behalf of the principal, or both, a dealer within the meaning of section 6574, as amended by section 3?" The holding of the attorney general is that in either case the corporation is a dealer embraced within the scope of the blue sky law, and whether he is required to furnish to the corporation commissioner information and not aside reserve to cover interim certificates required by the statute, depends on whether the interim certificates or any other memorandum of the sales contracts are issued at the time of the sale, the receipt of an installment on the sale, when the bond, certificate of stock or other security is not delivered.
