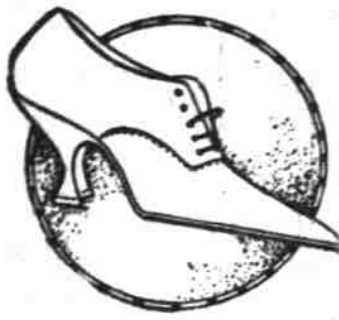

Lumber Output is Still 36 Percent Under Normal

For the week ending July 16, 1921, mills in western Oregon and western Washington report production at 49,852,574 feet, which is 35 per cent below normal. New business totaled 44,998,272 feet. Shipments totaled 46,592,613 feet.

For delivery by rail, new business included 1165 cars; rail shipments 1275 cars. Unshipped balance in the rail trade was 2942 cars. Local business totaled 3,573,369 feet.

In the cargo trade, domestic orders totaled 2,712,993 feet; export 3,762,000 feet. Coastwise and intercoastal cargo shipments totaled 3,457,419 feet; export shipments, 1,311,230 feet.

Bonds Are Certified For Irrigation District

The state irrigation securities commission, at a meeting held here yesterday, certified to bonds in the sum of \$100,000 issued by the Slide Irrigation District. This district includes approximately 14,000 acres and is situated on the Snake river in Eastern Oregon.

The money to be derived from the bonds will be used in development work.

More Weighing Jacks Are Received by State

Following the receipt of more weighing jacks yesterday, T. A.

Rafferty, chief inspector for the state motor vehicle department, announced that he had instructed his assistants to wage war on trucks carrying loads in excess of the weight allowed under the traffic laws. Information received at the motor vehicle department indicate that many trucks are carrying excessive loads, with the result that the highways are being menaced. As fact as violators of this law are apprehended they will be arrested and prosecuted, according to Mr. Rafferty.
