grounds. Paved street, cement walks,
concrete curbs, and paving said
portion of North Seventeenth
street with a six-inch Portland
cement concrete pavement in ac-
cordance with the plans and specifi-
cations thereof which were
adopted by the Common Council on
the 3rd day of April, 1922,
now on file in the office of the
City Recorder, and which for
greater certainty and convenience
and a more detailed description
thereof, are hereby referred to
and made a part hereof.

The Common Council hereby
declares its purpose and intention
to make the above described im-
provement by and through the
Street Improvement Department
of the City of Salem.
