Miles to Be Improved With Federal Aid

PORTLAND, Or., April 25 .-Nine Oregon road projects, involving construction of 130 miles of new highway and paving of 18, miles, have been approved to receive aid under the recent federal allotment by the secretary of agriculture, according to a telegram received by Philip Dater, district engineer of the forest service today.

All the roads come under the classification of forest service according to Dater. Among these are the Mussells creek section on the coast highway and the Anna creek section on the southeast approach to Crater Lake.

The roads approved are: Alsea river, coast highway (Mussels creek): Crescent - Klamath Falls, Eugene - Flore, McKenzie (surfacing Deschutes county section). Anna creek (southeast approach to Crater Lake); Trail - Prospect (west approach to Crater Lake); Prairie City - Unity, and a survey of the Willamette highway.
