

MISS RUBY WILSON DIES AT PORTLAND

She Was the Bookkeeper at the C. S. Hamilton Store for Fifteen Years

Miss Ruby Wilson died at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon at the Portland sanitarium. Miss Wilson was known by nearly all the people of the downtown district in Salem. She was far 15 years the bookkeeper in the C. S. Hamilton furniture store, where she was a trusted and valued member of the force.

A number of months ago she was obliged to give up her work on account of illness, and she finally developed tuberculosis. She was aged about 32 years. Two sisters in Portland survive her, Miss Marjory and Miss Georgia Wilson. Her mother lives at Florence, Lane county, where there are also two married sisters and a brother, Harvey. Funeral arrangements had not been announced last night.

issue while the attitude indicated in the Russian memorandum remained unchanged.

Officials Ahe Confident
It has been said repeatedly by American officials who have a hand in guiding the policies of the government that recognition of the soviet government by the United States and other countries would not set afoot the economic rehabilitation of Russia.

Administration officials generally are wholly confident that the American people would never approve recognition of the soviet regime and indicate their belief that the assembled delegates at Genoa should by now fully understand the fixed nature of the American policy of standing wholly aloof from any international arrangement that might have the appearance of moving toward such recognition.

European Capitals in Error
There seems to have arisen some misunderstanding in European capitals, nevertheless, and the very pointed reaffirmation of the American position here today undoubtedly was designed to clear away the last misapprehension in Genoa or any feeling that later concessions might induce the United States to enter a discussion resting in any way on the present Russian attitude.
