WHEAT AVERAGES LOWER FIGURE

Big Export Buying Yesterday Has Little Encouraging Effect on Market

CHICAGO, Aug. 3. - Despite big export buying, wheat averaged lower in price today, touching a fresh bottom record for the season. Selling pressure from the new crop was heavy. The market closed unsettled at half cent net decline to one-eighth cent ad- vance, with September \$1.05 3/4 to \$1.05 1/2 and December \$1.07 3/8 to \$1.07 1/2. Corn finished unchanged to 5-8 down. oats lost a shade to 3-8 a 1-2 and provisions 2 to 22 cents.

Lowest prices of the day in the wheat market were reached soon after the opening, and it was then that the export buying set in. About 1,000,000 bushels were purchased here for shipment to Europe and 500,000 more at the Atlantic seaboard. As a result of this stimulus, all deliveries of wheat here rallied to above yesterday's closing quotations, but the bulge led to increased selling and brought about another setback in values.

Speculative buying appeared to be principally nil. Prolonging of the rail and coal strikes was associated with reduced receipts at interior markets in the southwest but arrivals here were large, totaling 1,500 carloads. Primary receipts taken as a whole were again in excess of the aggregate a year ago, the excess however being only 400
