1923 GARDNER CAR IS AGAIN WINNER

Telegram Brings News That Car Again Wins First Place in Race.

The 1923 Gardner car again wins!

So states a telegram just received from the National Auto Import company of Mexico City, Mexico.

Joe Yanez, piloting a Gardner special, triumphed this week, retaining first place during the entire 102-mile race winning all prizes and defeating Pierce Arrow, Fiat, Paige, Steyer, Hudson, Marman and 10 other special cars.

This is the latest of a string of victories won by this Gardner special, piloted by Fred Harvey, noted dirt track driver. This same car won five out of eight main events at the Texas State fair in Dallas last fall. Won a championship match race at the Cotton Palace exhibit in Waco, Texas, the following week and the next week won a match race with Louis Disbrow, driving a Fiat on the Maxwellton mile dirt track at St. Louis.

A trainload of Oakland motor cars left the Oakland Motor Car company factory at Pontiac, Mich., February 26, bound for the Oakland Motor company of New England, Boston, Massachusetts. The train consisted of 36 cars.

Just as soon as a release is obtained from the railroads another train load will be shipped to the same point, according to W. R. Tracey, assistant sales

manager, who states the congestion to eastern points is hampering deliveries.

Four train loads of Oakland cars have been shipped to New York City since December 1, two since the beginning of the year.

These shipments are being made despite the severest snow-bound weather the east has encountered in several years. states Mr. Tracey, "due in great measure to the fact that the distributors and dealers realize that snow-bound weather does not in any way decrease the number of motor car prospects—simply puts over purchasing and delivery a

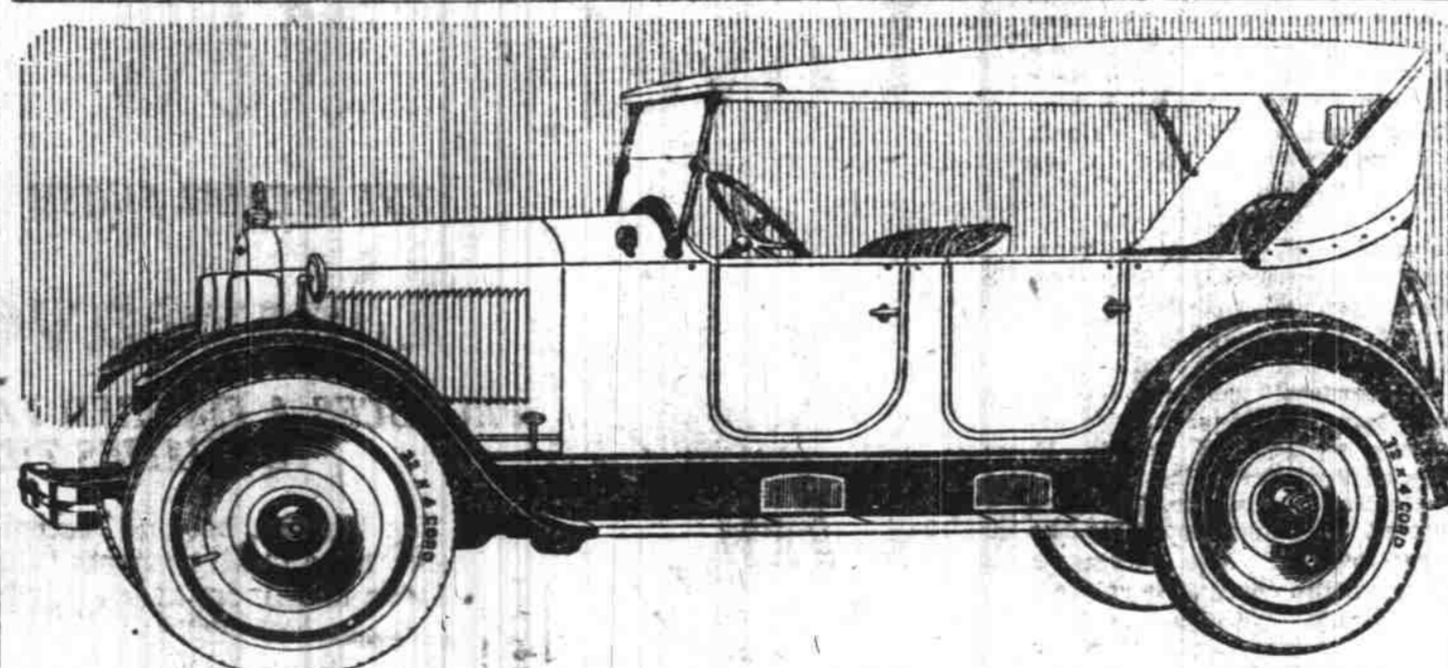
