## PRISONERS WILL HEAR MARCUSSEN

### Men's Service Official of Salvation Army Arranges Meetings in Salem.

The visiting men's social officers of the Salvation Army, Lieutenant Colonel Emil Marcussen, men's social secretary for the western territory, and Staff Captain and Mrs. Paul Heisinger, district social officers for Washington and Oregon, will arrive in Salem this afternoon and conduct the evening service at the Salvation Army hall.

Lieutenant Colonel Marcussen is the head of the prison work of the Salvation Army for the west, and while here will take up all the matter pertaining to the advancement of this special branch at the penitentiary. The local corps, commanded by Capt. A. M. Holbrook, has a membership in what is called the Brighter Day league of 65 and with about 20 more waiting for cards. This department of the Salvation Army work not only keeps the officer here in touch with the men whose days are darkened by having committed some wrong against society but also puts the army in touch with all who may be the erring one's dependents. In addition to this there are 35 regular Salvation soldiers in the institution. There were 61 and some have been discharged, but the sergeant major, the local officer who is also a converted prisoner, says that there are at least five more who are desirous of taking their stand as full soldiers and Christians.

Colonel Marcussen in his talk at the penitentiary Sunday morning will tell of some of the marvelous changes in men who have been there. He will address the boys at the training school at 11 a. m.
