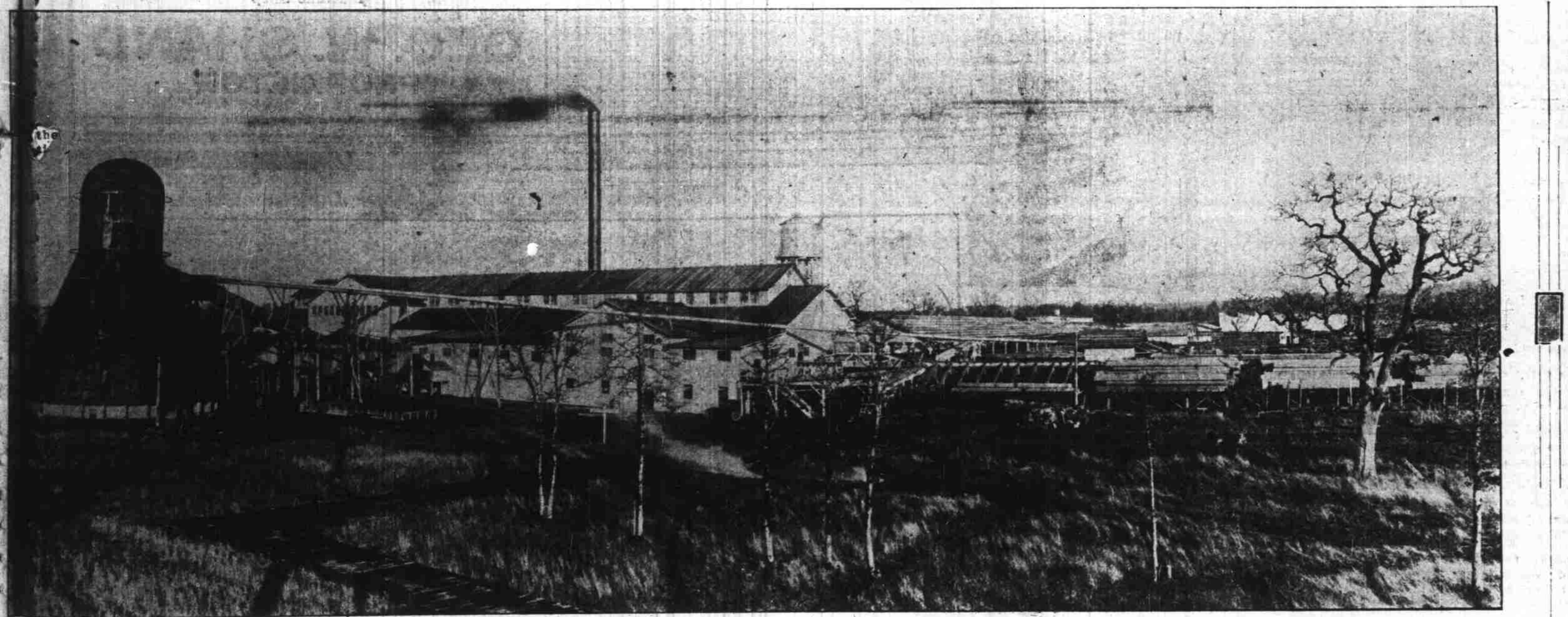
Civic Organizations Active
Silvertion is fortunate in having several civic organizations that take an active leadership. The Parent-Teacher association, organized in 1918, has for its object the raising of standards of home life and the bringing of the school and the home into closer relationship, that the parent and teacher may cooperate intelligently in the education of the child, and to initiate and stimulate any activity teaching child life, whether educational, legislative, moral or spiritual. It is affiliated with the state and county organization and at two consecutive meetings of the Marion county council won the silk flag, the reward that goes to the association in the county having the greatest number of members present. The Silvertion association has a membership of about one hundred.
