Grandson of Robert Ross Dies in Belfast, Ireland

Banks Pay Peking Police To Forestall Wage Strike

PEKING, May 26.—To prevent a strike of metropolitan police whose pay is five months in arrears, the native banks of the capital have subscribed half a million dollars as a loan to the military of finance which is said to have admitted its inability to hold any hope of relief for the strikers. Representatives of the banks, guilds and commercial institutions are agitating for a reorganization of the police force with a view to removing control from the central government and providing a more stable source of revenue for the pay.
