Five miles of the Old Oregon trail, between Deadman pass and Mecham is still in poor condition for travel, according to a state ment made yesterday by the state high way department. The re-mainder of the road between La Grande and Pendiston is maca-damized and in excellent condi-

"On account of the heavy traf-fic and the unfavorable weather conditions which have obtained for the past two weeks," asys the statement, "the five-mile section of the Old Oregon trail between Deadman pass and Meacham. which section is now under con-struction, has become badly cut up and is difficult to travel. Reup and is difficult to travel. Re-pairs are now in progress, and with favorable weather the road-will be in good condition within the next few days. In the mean-time teams have been stationed at all points where there is a pos-sibility of machines getting attack.
