Opening Prices Heavy; Selling By Professionals Is Feature of Day

NEW YORK, July 30 .- Prices sharpened in the latter part of today's stock market upon the lifting of selling pressure which had been in evidence since Friday morning. Opening prices were heavy, due to an accumulation of week-end selling orders, but many of the standard industrialists exhibited a rally. Much of the selling came from professional traders but commission house also was extensive, particularly from western points. This was influenced in part by the president's illness, the unfavorable condition of the wheat market and the pessimistic news from abroad which was also reflected in the lower foreign exchange.

One of the interesting events of the session was that of another low for the year by United States Steel common, which touched 85 3-4 and then rallied to 87 1-8 for a slight fractional gain on the day. Heaviness of this issue and that 30 blast furnaces had closed down in the Pittsburgh district. However, the quarterly report of the corn outlook which is to be issued after the close of business tomorrow is expected to show an increase in earnings over the first quarter.
