S. Ray, federal crop estimator. The estimate issued, as of August 1 is based on figures taken from the monthly reports of the bureau of crop estimates by G. S. Ray of Washington, F. L. Kent of Oregon and Julius H. Jacobson for Idaho. Winter wheat is put at 69,277,-000 and spring wheat at 43,637,-000 bushels.

The yield for Idaho sets a recington's crop of 58,202,000 bushels and Oregon's of 26,056,000 bushels exceed the five-year averages for these states. The state average for Idaho is put by Mr. Jacobson at 27 bu
