completely, giving street address whenever possible. Place sender's name and address in upper left corner of address

Pack articles carefully in strong durable containers.

Wrap parcels securely but do not seal them except when bearing a printed label or indorsement reading: "Contents: Merchandise -Fourth Class Mail. Postmaster: This parcel may be opened for postal inspection if necessary," as sealed parcels not so labeled or indorsed are subject to postage at

Parcels may be marked "Do n21e not open until Christmas." Insure valuable parcels.
