Get newspaper comments concerning the coming of Billy Sunday to Salem in June, I think it worth while to state the reasons for the negative vote of the board of the First Christian church.

"In common with many, we think the time inopportune. If it were a matter that concerned our local organization alone, it would not think of calling a specialist for such a work at that particular season of the year, and we can see no advantage as it relates to the wider aspect.

"In the second place, our convention of churches in Oregon is booked for Turner beginning July 5 and closing the 13th. The proposal of Mr. Sunday for a six-Leaves Central Stage Terminal, Sales week campaign would overlap this date and would greatly injure our prospects of a successful convention, for if his influence did not reach as far as Turner he would not do the work expected of him. Our state convention is to our churches what the annual state gatherings are to other communions. Our entire year's work throughout the state is involved, both as to past and future. It is impossible to change the date of the convention as it is a link in a chain of coast state conventions. We do not feel justified in hindering that gathering.

> "In the third place we do not ee our way clear to give the amount of guarantee requested by Mr. Sunday. The churches are presumed to underwrite the following expenses: The cost of a tabernacle seating 7500 people. \$700 or \$800 traveling expenses of the company; their rooms and living expenses while in Salem; \$2500 for two-thirds of the salar-Sunday, a total of approximately \$10,000-perhaps more. This must be underwritten by the churches or individuals representing the churches. But in any event it comes from the churches.
