If the lights are to be turned on at 5:00 o'clock in the morning, grain may be scattered in the litter after the hens have gone to roost. There should always be fresh water. In cold weather water may be kept from freezing by burning a lantern in some suitable contrivance. It is also a good plan to turn the light on for about an hour at 8:30 or 9:00 p. m., and give the hens a heavy feed in a trough. They will learn in a very short time to immediately jump down and eat and return to the roost before the lights are turned off.
