219 LISTINGS ARE NOW HELD

Multiple Bureau Reports Unusual Activity During the Past Week

With 18 new listings added to the multiple listing bureau of the Marion-Polk County Realty association during the last week, there are now a total of 219 listings in effect, according to Miss Martha Leavenworth, executive secretary.

Fifty-One New Lots are For Sale in Additions

Fifty-one lots in the Yew Park and University additions have been placed on the market through the multiple listing bureau of the Marion-Polk County Realty association.
