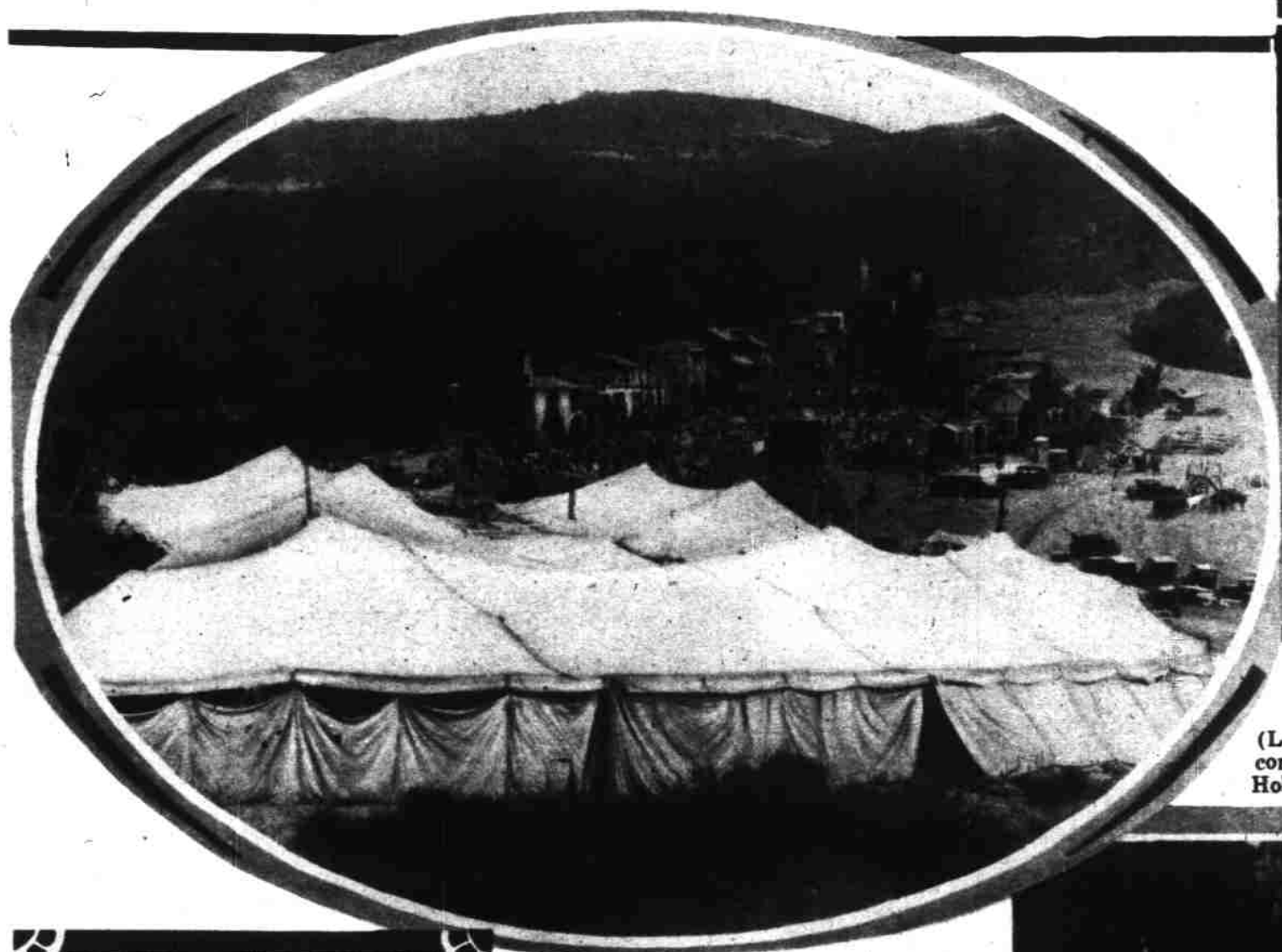
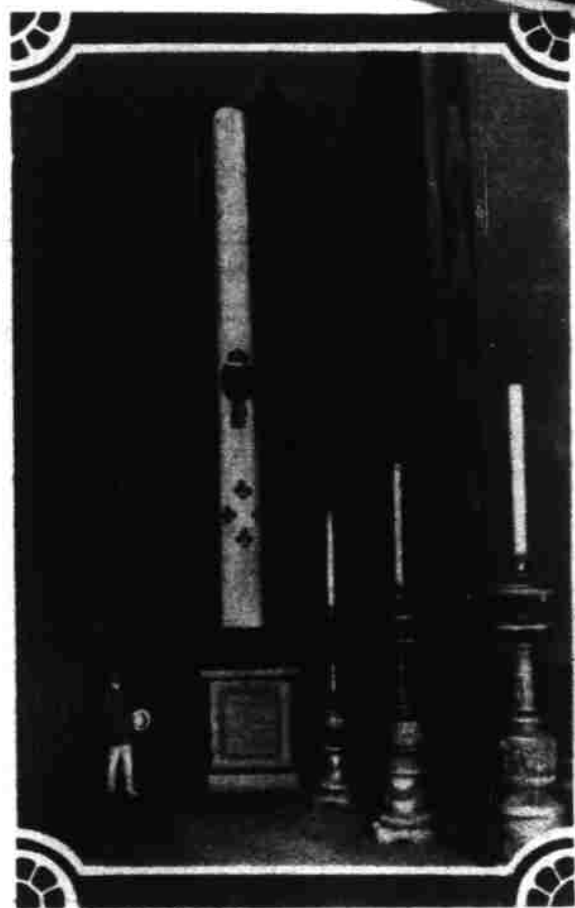

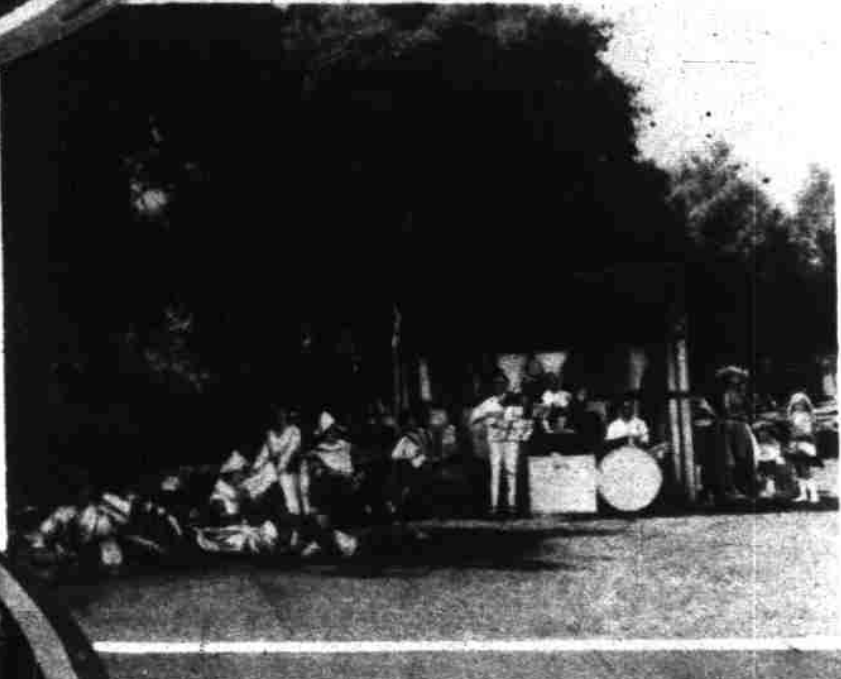
(Above). Two stars, Pola Negri and William T. Tilden, 2d, American tennis champion
