J. A. Churchill, state superintendent of schools, is now distributing to the standard clubs of the state the Red Book, official publication of the Boys' and Girls' Industrial clubs of Oregon.

The Red Book is largely a compilation of stories written by members of the clubs who carried to successful conclusion the projects undertaken by them, and whose exhibitions of club work received recognition at the state fair and the International Livestock exposition last fall.

"Each story," said Mr. Churchill, "gives a detailed account of the achievement of the boy or girl in the project work, and of its value to him or her in acquiring habits of thrift, work and leadership."

Other features of the pamphlet are thrift quotations, proverbs, maxims, old sayings, a picture of Luther Burbank and the Oregon club creed.
