#### m 28-29-30. Strawberries May Be Picked Without Stems

Commerce Bldg. Court Street

Christian church, Salem, Ore .-

Stemless picking of strawberries will be tried out in the Salem district this season, according to R. I. McLoughlin, of Baker, Kelly & McLaughlin, fruit buyers, who has returned from a buying trip to Washington points and who will remain until the season is over with the exception of short trips away from Salem. Growers will be paid 2 cents a pound more than the regular market for strawberries that are picked in the field without stems. This offer will be made to selected growers.

While the berries can be picked stemmed for half a cent a pound more, and the shrinkage from the lack of stems to the grower does not amount to more than a cent a pound, by paying the grower 2 cents more a pound, he is given an additional profit and the buyer is able to save money, it was explained by Mr. McLaughlin. In the barreling process where the berries are stemmed, the shrinkage is very heavy, and it costs about a cent a pound to stem the berries in the barreling house in addition to the loss sustained by the shrink-

Three hundred tons of berries, covering about 200 acres, have been purchased, Mr. McLaughlin said. Certain growers will be selected to introduce stemless picking with the hope of making the method universal.
