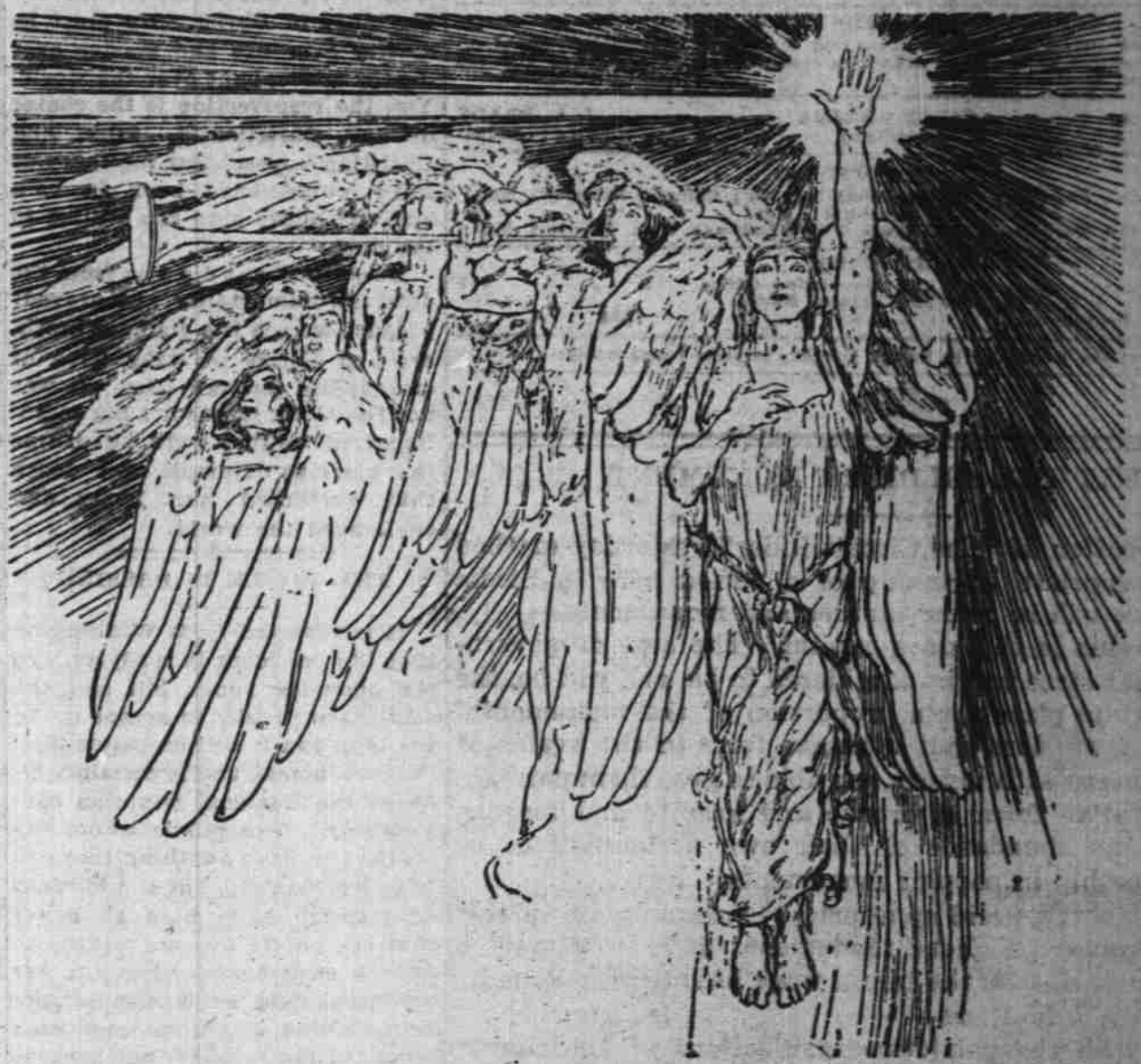


GOOD BLESSINGS Sunday and EVERY SUNDAY
