The death of Hazel Hall Sunday morning at dawn startled not from its unexpectedness, but from its clear pathos. Having been an invalid all her life, the last few weeks' iliness came as no new thing. Hazel Hall virtually wrote her own epitaph. Her last poem was coincidently named "Slow Death," and epitomized in a brief. lyric her long life of invalidism.

Hazel Hall never walked. Yet her last book was named "Walkers,"-the "walkers" that passed by her window day in, day out as she watched, through the curtains which named her first book. A third volume will be published this September. Miss Hall wrote eagerly till the

day of her death. Her life as a poet she lived in exactly eight years. But the brevity of the time will not matter. Her verse will doubtless live. She had enviable standing with magazines of such literary quality as the New Republic, Poetry, A Magazine of Verse, The Literary Review, Contemporary Verse, and Current Opinion. She has appeared numbers of times in the leading anthologies and has won several distinctive poetry prizes. But now her prize is death.

Miss Hall was 38 years of ago. Many will express surprise at the years, she seemed always so childlike to those who knew her. But the many of her friends have known her only in her verses, or, at most, through the lovely portrait in color that hange in the Poets' corner at the J. K. Dill book store. When the picture was placed last May, apple biossoms filled to overflowing the vasca about the room. Apple blossoms seem now only a part of the pic-
