The two this week are dissimilar as usual but both the winning ones were wholesome and inspiring. Here is the first. Editor Statesman:

I sometimes wonder if Salem people appreciate the biggest factory they have. No it is not the public schools although they are mighty important. Our biggest factory is owned by outside capital and the money spent here helps all of us. The Willamette university students are referred to. They come from many places, many states, in fact, and they spend their money here. I wonder if we properly appreciate both their money and their moral value. Editor Statesman: The best asset this city has is its flowers. They give us the name of being the most beautiful city in Oregon and that means much. Oregon is proud of its cities and all of them take Salem as a pattern. Our state house grounds are marvelously beautiful and the Institution is almost ideal. 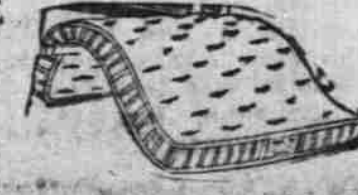

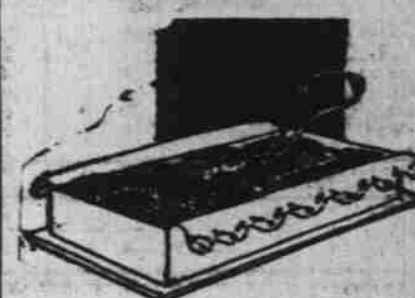
