It is emphasized that sigbility of this projection is depend-ent upon liquidation of loans within the markin of safety provided. Whether it is stated that in the event of deflation of present high appraised values, before liquidaon has substantially reduced the loans, it is evident that heavy osses will be sustained, destroying the value of all attempts to fore-

east sinking fund requirements. The balance of loan notes is \$12.698.207.11. The report recognizes the difficulties encountered by the commission in discriminating relative to loan approvals for the reason that it is mandatory to approve loans based on 75 per cent of appraised value. "Therefore," says the report, "it cannot be expected that the loans will meet standards of gilt-edge mortgages. The commission could not reject loans from speculative districts or from applicants of questionable moral risk where the applicant possessed all the etatutitle him to a loan and had compiled with the requirements of the bonus law.
