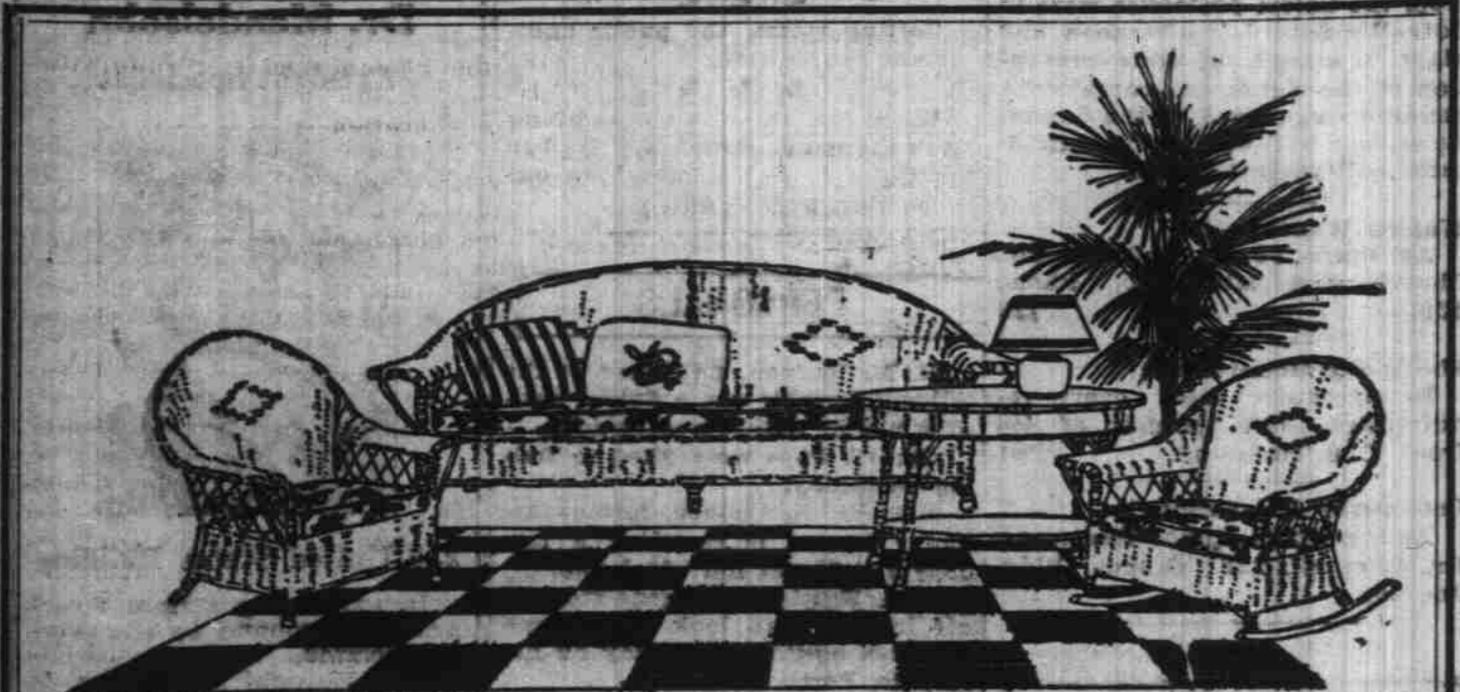

state was challenged. Many dele-



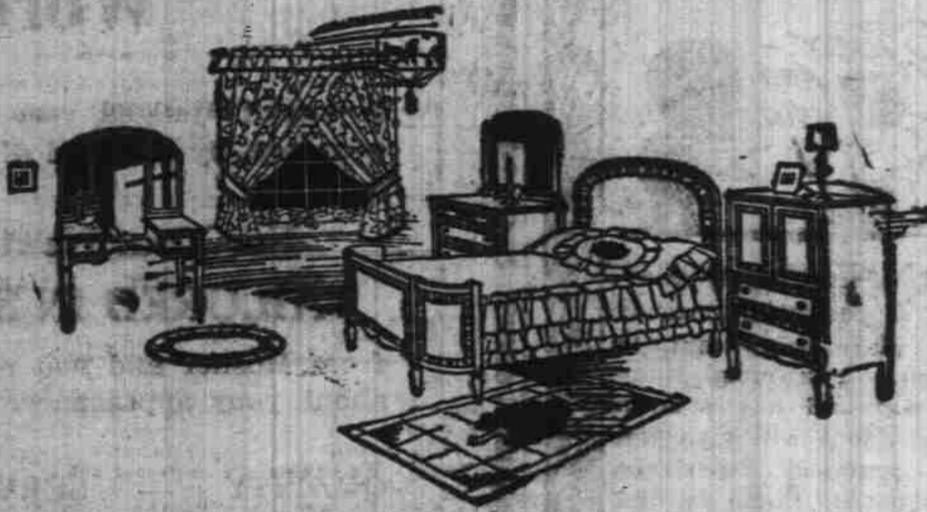

my life that compares with the league of nations.
"The man who ought to be pleading this cause here is dead; calling from consecrated ground."
Scoring the majority plank in detail as being composed of provisions which would lead to nothing, Mr. Baker exclaimed:
"My boy will be dead on a battlefield and a tombstone will be placed over his grave before the senate gets to full and due consideration of this question in the way proposed here."
Mr. Baker, in his emotion, almost climbed up over the speaker's desk with gestures to his audience. In a dramatic climax which brought the convention to its feet with roars of cheers and approval, Mr. Baker exclaimed:
"I served Woodrow Wilson for five years. He is standing at the throne of a God whose approval he deserved and won. As he looks down I reply 'I am doing my best. Weak as I am, weak as is my voice, you are still the captain of my soul.' And that great leader is saying not in the shrunk voice of the figure which I last saw, but in the voice of the majestic leader, 'Carry on; do America's duty.'"
As Mr. Baker concluded and was surrounded by associates of the late president on the platform he was embraced by Joseph P. Tumulty, who was President Wilson's secretary. During the course of his argument, Mr. Baker delivered a scathing denunciation of Senator Henry Cabot Lodge, whom he referred to as not a person but a malevolent institution.

OLIO REFERENDUM
"I am afraid that unless the dairymen get busy and spend some money they're going to get licked in the olio referendum," warned State Senator Sam Brown of Gervais, Marion county. "I get the surprise of my life every once in a while at the amount of that stuff that is used—and by dairymen, too, who, storekeepers tell me, bring in their own products and take back substitutes. I can't for the life of me see how a farmer can be so inconsistent."
Senator Brown's influence was one of the principal factors in the passage of the anti-olio bill which now is the subject of referendum, and he is deeply interested in seeing the measure sustained at the polls this fall. Asked about conditions in his section prior to the tight rainfall, the first week in June, he said: "Things up the valley are all right in spite of the lack of rain will hurt. Early strawberries have been damaged and the later varieties will be, without rain. My logans look as though a cyclone had struck them, and I have plowed out half of them, but, of course, most of the damage to them was due to the cold of last winter. My evergreens never looked finer, and unless the drought is extended we'll have a bumper crop. Grain still is all right."—Oregon Farmer.
