chair, crossed his fingers over his vest and for the next four and a half hours of court session held that pose while the lawyers wrangled.

From the outset Mr. Crowe argued that the plea of guilty had effectually barred from the proceedings any offer of insanity as a legal defense. Judge Caverly pointed out that the defense had given no indication of what they expected to prove by Dr. White's

ing arguments and the judge called for authorities. Thomas Marshall, the state's atorney's expert on indictments and other intricacies of the law, was given the floor. Hour after hour he read the court records of Colorado, Georgia, Mississippi, Pennsylvania, Nebraska and Gre.t
