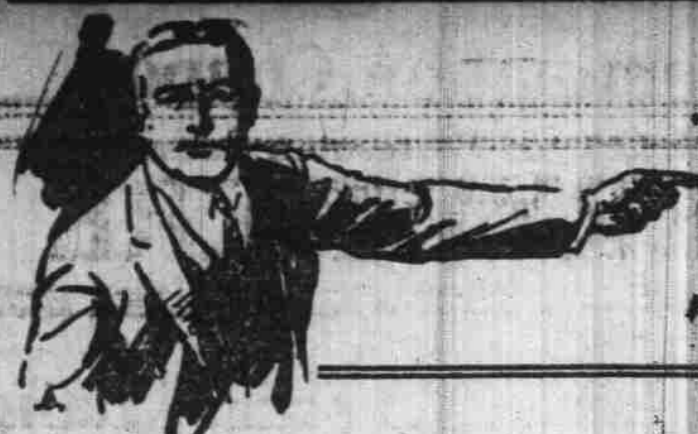

### SALEM SPIRIT AT ITS BEST

Our Treatment of Migrant  
Workers and Forest Pro-  
tection Come in for Gen-  
eral Praise.

Hop picking would be the  
order of the day but for the  
rain. The rain was so badly  
needed that the hops can af-  
ford to wait. They are not  
very ripe anyway. The hop  
crop is a good one this year  
and the market is satisfac-  
tory. There is a good deal of  
attention being paid to the  
pickers this year, the first  
time there has been any gen-  
eral movement to look after  
the migrant workers.  
Salem is getting a lot of  
good advertising by its efforts  
to make the working condi-  
tions of the migrant workers  
better. The finest part of it  
is that the hop growers are  
taking the lead and furnish-  
ing the money to do the work.

#### Editor Statesman:

This is my second year in  
the hop fields of Salem. I  
have worked in many other  
places. I am what you call a  
migrant worker. I go from  
place to place and find em-  
ployment in seasonable occu-  
pations. I manage to make a  
fair living. As I said I have  
worked many places but I  
find the Salem atmosphere  
the best of all. It is unusual  
to find these large employers  
of labor devoting much atten-  
tion to their laborers as in-  
dividuals. They have always  
been too busy. But they are  
showing their hearts and in-  
terest in the welfare of the in-  
dividual workers this year by  
putting on these welfare plans.  
It is not patronage, it is just  
human interest and as a work-  
er I want to acknowledge it.

I read the letter of Mrs.  
Long last week. I do not have  
a family but I do have eyes  
and I see the fine part of this  
helpful work. Some thought  
the workers might resent it  
but they welcome it. They  
would not cooperate so earn-  
estly if they felt they did not.

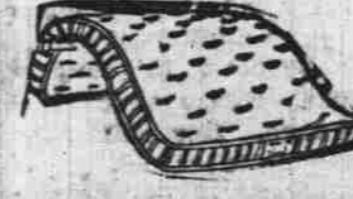
