it had been referred back by the court. "I refer particularly to the fact," says McCoy, "that the majority members of the commission have held at least ex parte conferences with the attorneys and traffic men of the carriers without any notice being given to the shippers." McCoy declares that if the majority members had not seen fit to change previous orders "the shippers might possibly have no cause of complaint for not being notified, but, since the rates provided and prescribed by said orders have been materially raised by (his order (the modified order) the shippers should have been called in and given an oportunity to register their objections and of-

fer such arguments as they saw McCoy avers that the arguments of the railroad attorneys before the court were substantially the same as before the commission. and that the commission had passed on all the important points at

That the relief granted to the hay growers by the previous order has been practically nullified by the modified order is an assertion of Mr. McCoy.

"Take, for instance," he says, the rate on hay from Hermiston o Portaind; on the old basis it was 21½ cents per hundred pounds, was reduced by order 1027 (the previous order) to 18 cents and is raised by this order to 201/2 cents; and the difference on the rate from Hermiston to Tillamook, as prescribed by order 1027, and the present order, is 90 cents a ton or \$12.40 per car of 15.3 tons, which is the amount of the average carload of hay carried from Heriston to Tillamook. The difference in the haul of 200 miles is 50 cents a ton, single line, or \$7.65 per car; and for a joint haul, said distance, is 2 cents per hundred, or \$15.30 per car."

Mr. McCoy cites the law and court opinion in an effort to show that "court is not justified in reversing or modifying the orders of a public service commission unless the commission has acted with out testimony, or against testimony, or otherwise abused its discretion to a point almost reaching the degree of fraud." and he asserts that "the abandonment by the majority of this commission of the salutary and just rates laid down by its orders amounts to a producers."
