

he was forced to support himself from childhood and had been a miner and a logger, "Prohibition was not put over by the teetotalers," he charged, but by the men who were drinkers and knew the evil of it."

McMahan then recited his newspaper career and how he had fought the saloons at Woodburn and Salem. He asserted that he had kept saloons out of Woodburn and how he fought them in Salem until he was so hated "that they released convicts from the penitentiary to kill me." He told of his failure in business by reason of boycott because of his an-

tagonism to the saloon interests. "In those days," he said, "your politics were framed in the back rooms of saloons and I was one of the first men who caw the evil and fought it."

Judge McMahan asserted that President Carl G. Doney of Willamette university and Rev. Dr. Avison, Salem Methodist pastor for many years, urged Governor Pierce to appoint him because they had confidence in him.

The judge prefaced his remarks by saying that he was prompted to speak to clear his good name with strangers and not to ask his audience for support as he had never in all his lifetime asked an elector to vote for him.
