Woodburn Guard Defeated 52-14; High School Second Team 24 to 3

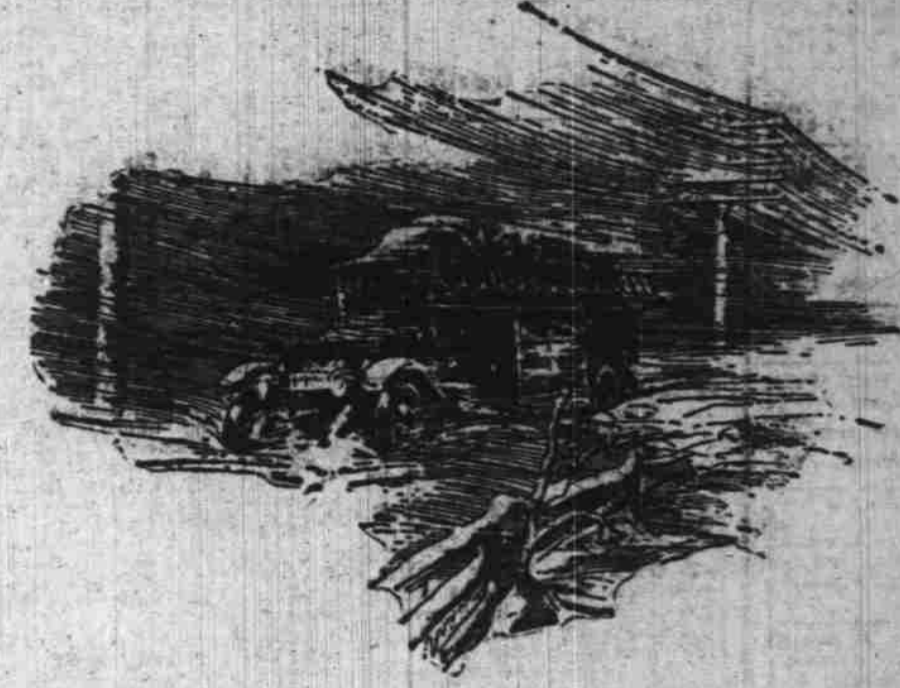

Pierce, as Governor of the State of Oregon, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by Section 6913, Olson's Oregon Laws, and under and pursuant to the terms and provisions thereof, do hereby declare the right of each and all of the foregoing and the foregoing and above to transact business in the State of Oregon revoked and repealed, and all powers conferred by the foregoing and above are hereby declared inoperative and void.

In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of State to be hereunto affixed at the City of Salem, State of Oregon, this 6th day of January, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Five.
