The terms of the lease would be on a minimum basis of 4 per cent annually on the cost of construction of dam No. 2 and of the hydro-electric machinery installed there. The lessee would be required

to produce 40.000 tons of nitrate annually during the life of the contract after the fifth year from its effective date.

This nitrate would be converted nto fertilizer during peace time but in the event of war, the government would have full authorfarm.
