Both Senate Bills No. 5 and 21 were reported on the Judiciary committee, with a recommendation that they be passed by the senate. They were placed on the calendar. The Senate Concurrent Resolutions Nos. 1 and 2 were signed by the president of the house.

Seven bills were introduced dur ng the morning session.

The one commanding the most attention was proposed by Senator Isaac, E. Staples, of Multnomah county, and provides for an increase of the salary of the judges of the supreme court of from \$5,-200 to \$7500 to be payable monthly in the same manner as the salary of other officers. This proposal is known as Senate Bill No.

Senate Bill No. 25, introduced by the senate committee on education, would amend chapter 5040 of the general laws of Oregon, and has reference to the hiring of, and making of contracts with teachers. It provides that relatives of the school board may be hired under certain conditions. but that no teacher related to any member of the board by consanguinity within the third degree may be hired without the unanimous approval of all members of the board.


