Cuban Doctors Endorse Progressive Legislation HAVANA, Jan. 25.—Legislation designed to improve working and living conditions of women and children in industry, and of men laboring in the cane field and sugar mills, was recommended in a series of 58 resolutions adopted by the Cuban National Medical Congress which has just closed its sixth annual session here. The congress especially would have hours of working women and children regulated, and favors a law requiring working women to cease work for four weeks before and after child birth. The congress also went on record as favoring an effective law against importation of narcotics for stricter legislation against carrying fire arms, for standardizing medical drugs and for protection of the meat and milk supplies of the public, and many other measures to improve living conditions.
