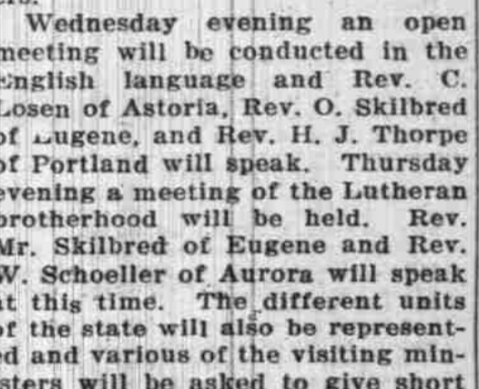
Lutheran Ministers Are Gathering at Silverton
