Regional Director Arrives
and Places Local Units
on Firm Foundation

Complete reorganization of the Boy Scouts of Salem is being undertaken by G. H. Oberbauer, regional director for the four Pacific states during his stay here. Thorough cooperation was shown by the local council which met at the Scout offices in the Oregon building last night.

Harold Ware is to be employed as scout executive in Marion county. He comes recommended by

his work here in summer camp, work and by his past record in Scout activities. Ware attained the highest rank in Scoutdom, and has spent the last three years as a professional Scout director.

In addition to the reorganization the refinancing of the district will be finished within the next two months, and this will enable the Scouts to carry out an extensive program.

While in this district the regional executives will organize councils in Polk and Benton counties as well as in Marion county.

Part of the 10 day visit is to be spent in Dallas and Corvallis. It is expected that the example set by the Salem council will be followed by the other councils.

REIMBURSE WEST RESOLUTION AIM

Legislators Plan Having
Little Fun at Expense of
Former Governor

Copies of a resolution that was expected to be offered in the house yesterday were distributed to the press. The resolution was drafted after Oswald West, former governor, had taken opportunity to appear before the open hearing Monday night and oppose the present law.

The resolution, as drafted, should not be taken too seriously, as it is to be offered merely as a pastime. It is as follows:

Whereas, at a meeting of the Joint Committee on Alcoholic Traffic, assembled in the house of representatives for an open hearing in the investigation of the administration of the state prohibition department, Senator Garland, chairman, invited Oswald West, ex-governor of Oregon, to the platform; and

Whereas, the said Oswald West, ex-governor of the state of Oregon, in his criticism of the present administration of the prohibition enforcement law, made conflicting statements, to-wit: That the enforcement of said department during his administration was solely in the hands of the county officers, and again stated that the funds for the said enforcement came entirely from his own purse, and believing that this might possibly be true, recalling the Corbett case, when he sent from his office his secretary, Miss Fern Hobbs, to shut up the town, without the aid and entirely contrary to the wishes of said sheriff of that county;

Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the house of representatives, the senate concurring, ask and demand that the board of control immediately upon receipt of sworn statement of such expenditures by the said Oswald West, ex-governor of the state of Oregon, for the purpose hereinbefore mentioned, order the state treasurer to immediately reimburse the said Oswald West, ex-governor of the state of Oregon; and be it

Further Resolved, that this body heartily deprecates that this duty debt has been so long unpaid; that the years have passed and this has not been brought to the knowledge of the state of Oregon; and be it

Further Resolved, that the state of Oregon, even at this late hour, endeavor to take this blot off its escutcheon, and extend to the said Oswald West our gratitude for the tremendous work he said he accomplished, and we believe his name will go down in history as one of the greatest philanthropists of his time, and we assure the said Oswald West, ex-governor of the state of Oregon, that had he been known the said state's indebtedness to him, in the legal, logical way, it would have long since been paid.

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
