Playing of the families of railroad men and traveling men under the present qualifications of students, officers and employees of the state and government who are listed under the absent voting law is effected by HB No. 362, which was passed yesterday.

Seeking to benefit farmers, SB No. 16, changing the dates for payment of taxes to May 5 for the first half and November 5 for the second half, one month later than at present, the house gave its approval to the measure. A movement was made along this line two years ago, but was rejected after objections were raised by the Multnomah county delegation.

HB No. 207, upon the rejection or acceptance of bail before a justice of the peace, and HB No. 280, covering the jurisdiction of justice and circuit courts upon sentences imposed for passing worthless checks or checks issued without sufficient funds in the bank. A jail sentence may be imposed and a term in the penitentiary, not mandatory under the provisions of the measure.

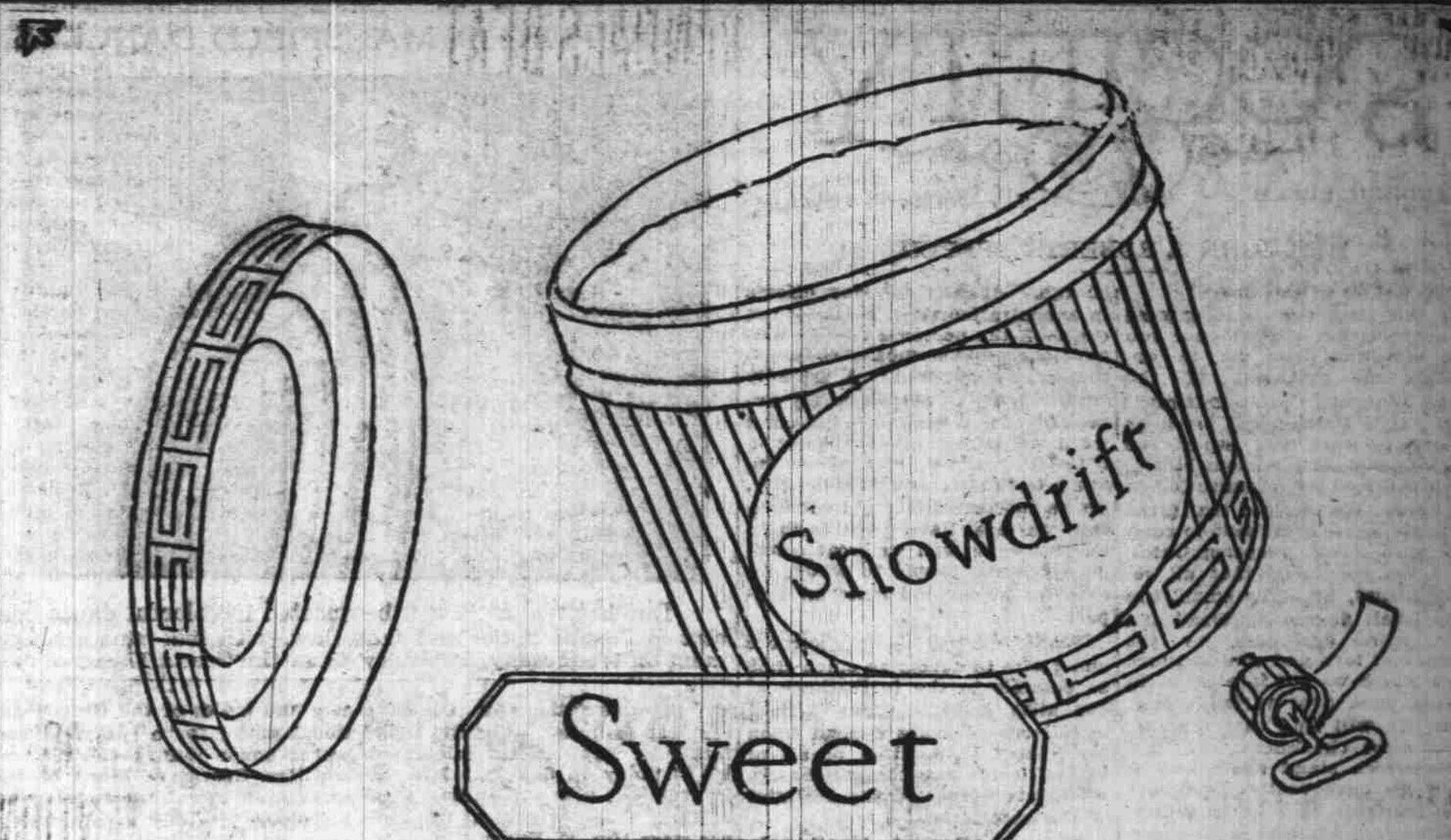
