SEATTLE, Mar. 2 .- Announcement of a \$3,000,000 foundation to supplement a Rhodes scholarship fund, available to graduate students in all American universities, was received here today by President Henry Suzzallo of the University of Washington.

The gift was made by Simeon Guggenheim and is to be known as the John Simon Guggenheim foundation after John Guggenheim who died in 1922. The new foundation is to aid men and women graduates over 25 years of age in research work. Each fellowship is to carry about \$2500 with it, including an opportunity for study abroad.

search of a store, dwelling house or other structure in respect of which a proper warrant readily may be obtained and a search of a ship, motorboat, wagon or automobile for contraband goods where it is not possible to secure a warrant because the vehicle can be quickly moved out of the locality or jurisdiction in which the warrant must be sought."

The mere manufacture of liquor can do little to defeat the prohibition amendment unless the liquor can be distributed for illegale sale and use, the court asserted, and for that reason, it was necessary that the transportation of the contraband be prevented. The right to be applied in determiining the legality of a seizure without a warrant, as laid down by the court, is whether the seizing officer has reasonable or probable cause for believing the automobile which he stops and seizes has contraband liquor in it which is being illegally transported. This is ample protection to the individual in the opinion of the cour because it gives him the right to bage and refuse of all kinds removed by the month.
