DOLLARS AND CHIX BY THE THOUSAND

Fir Lane Poultry Farm Hatches 8000 Chix Every Week During Season

The Fir Lane Poultry Farm, at

Canby, owned by Mr. and Mrs. W, H. Thompson, is one of the busiest and most profitable 12 acres in Oregon. Its chief feature is the mammoth Smith incubator, capaeity 47,000 eggs. To start this machine going 6,500 eggs are set twice a week. Three weeks later the chicks begin to hatch and the big hen is at her maximum production for the next 20 weeks. Eggs for this machine are bought from Fir Lane customers, using trapnested cockerels of high producing strain. No electrically forced stock is used, thus insuring strong hardy chicks which are shipped to all parts of the west. Chicks sell at 15 to 20 cents each. After May 1st the price will be reduced 20 per cent. The farm will have some pullets for sale from its own brooders which now have more than 6,000 chicks from 2 to 5 weeks old getting ready to supply the incubator next season. 3,000 breeders will be grown for the Fir Lane farm this season.

Practically the entire April hatch from this mighty incubator is already engaged. This is the second year the Fir Lane farm has operated this Smith machine, and hey pronounce it an unalloyed success, producing stronger and hardier chicks than any other machine on the market.

The baby chick industry is growng by leaps and bounds and has carcely made a beginning yet. regon quality chicks command a remium on the market and the upply has never yet filled the deand, although the season of 1925 ill witness the sale of more than million chicks from Salem disrict hatcheries.
