Fir Lane Poultry Farm
Hatches 8000 Chix Every Week During Season

The Fir Lane Poultry Farm, at Canby, owned by Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Thompson, is one of the busiest and most profitable 12 acres in Oregon. Its chief feature is the mammoth Smith incubator, capacity 47,000 eggs. To start this machine going 6,500 eggs are set twice a week. Three weeks later the chicks begin to hatch and the big hen is at her maximum production for the next 20 weeks. Eggs for this machine are bought from Fir Lane customers, using trapped cockerels of high producing strain. No electrically forced stock is used, thus insuring strong hardy chicks which are shipped to all parts of the west. Chicks sell at 15 to 20 cents each. After May 1st the price will be reduced 20 per cent. The farm will have some pullets for sale from its own brooders which now have more than 6,000 chicks from 2 to 5 weeks old getting ready to supply the incubator next season. 3,000 breeders will be grown for the Fir Lane farm this season.
Practically the entire April hatch from this mighty incubator is already engaged. This is the second year the Fir Lane farm has operated this Smith machine, and they pronounce it an unalloyed success, producing stronger and hardier chicks than any other machine on the market.
The baby chick industry is growing by leaps and bounds and has scarcely made a beginning yet. Oregon quality chicks command a premium on the market and the supply has never yet filled the demand, although the season of 1925 will witness the sale of more than a million chicks from Salem district hatcheries.
The Fir Lane Farm can supply you with any variety desired, but by far its greatest demand is for white Leghorns with high production records behind them. Orders should be sent to Canby, Oregon.

LOWER VALLEY IS INVESTIGATING FLAX

otto valley, these plants for threshing, retting, breaking and scutching the straw will be necessary—absolutely. There can be no further growth without them. The state flax plant at the penitentiary, with some additional retting tanks, will soon be up to capacity—up to the available men who can be profitably worked in that process. The next step at the penitentiary will be spinning yarn; if there is to be a next step there. But the next step from growing the flax on the farms must be putting it in shape for the markets, in seed and fiber form.
It will cost perhaps \$25,000 to equip a plant for treating the flax up to the fiber stage; including necessary warehouses. These plants may be owned and operated as straight manufacturing con-

cerns, or they may be owned and operated cooperatively. Those are problems that will have to be worked out, for each community.
February Fire Loss in State Amounts to \$39,500
Property amounting to \$39,350 was destroyed in the 14 fires outside of Portland during February, according to a report from the office of the state fire marshal. The heaviest loss was sustained by Elk City, with a store and stock valued at \$15,000 and a hotel at \$5000 being destroyed. Eight dwellings and their contents were consumed, representing an aggregate loss of \$14,150.
Of the 14 fires, six were caused by unknown sources, three by stoves and pipes, two by explosions and one each from conflagration, incendiary and petroleum and its products.
