CERTIFICATION OF POTATOES PAYING
Potato growers in the northwest are obtaining better yields by using certified seed. The merit of certification is slowly becoming understood by the general class of farmers. A large number of inquiries have been received this year from farmers, by the OAC experiment station at Corvallis. While planting certified seed will not always result in a crop that will pass certification requirements, it usually means a considerably better yield of potatoes. The potatoes will be more uniform and have less culls than where the common potatoes are used for seed. Certified potatoes must be of uniform shape and size, showing the varietal characteristics, and comparatively free from disease. But do not think that because they are free from disease you will get disease-free potatoes that season. Potatoes may become infected from diseased soil or containers before planting. Always treat the potato seed before planting. It serves as a disinfectant for the seed and kills the disease organisms that may have reached the surface of the seed from the containers. Use corrosive sublimate for treating them before the seed is cut for planting.

DELICIOUS AS KEEPERS
The keeping qualities of the Golden Delicious apple in western Oregon are being studied at the Oregon Agricultural college experiment station. In eastern Oregon this variety has proved one of the best. There it develops a good waxy cuticle, which has been found to add to the keeping quality of most varieties. In the western part of the state, though it bears well, the fruit does not keep like the eastern product. However, the trees are still young, and the station hopes that as they become older the fruit will develop this waxing covering.
