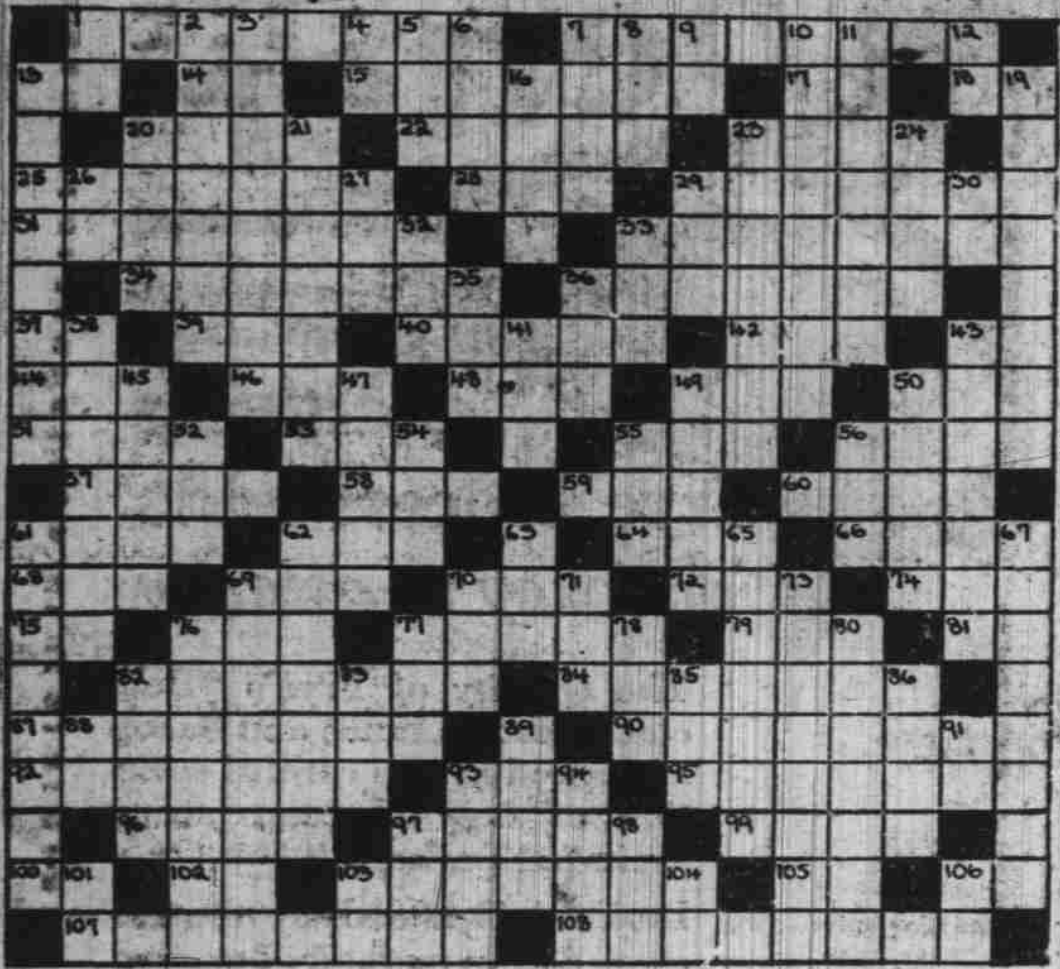

POSTAL RATES RISE APRIL 15

New Schedule Brings About Re-Classification of Various Mailing Matters

Postage rates for mail matter will be changed April 15 by the postal department. As a result changes are made in certain articles of first class matter, transient material and will affect publishers of reading and advertising, newspapers and periodicals, printed matter, merchandise, special services on money orders, registered mail and special delivery.

In the first class matter post-cards (private mailing cards) will be charged 2 cents, while second class transient matter will be eight ounces and under 2 cents, and each two ounces over the eight ounces will be rated as parcel post rates.

Publishers of scientific, agricultural, religious, newspapers and periodicals, reading matter will be at 1 1/2 cents per pound.

Zone rates for advertising are given as 2 cents in zones 1 and 2; 3 cents in zones 4 to 5; 6 cents in zones 5 and 6, and zones 7 and 8 will be rated at 9 cents.

Third class printed matter will be sent, 8 ounces and under for 1 1/2 cents each 2 ounces, over the 8 ounces will be charged as fourth class matter.

Books and catalogs, seeds, bulbs, cuttings, roots, scions and plants will be sent 8 ounces and under, rated in fourth class matter.

1 cent for each two ounces, over the stipulated amount will be merchandise is rated at 1 1/2 cents for each 2 ounces under an 8-ounce package; anything over that amount is automatically brought into the next division of mailing matter.

Fourth class matter, which includes books, catalogs, seeds, bulbs, scions and plants, will be rated at 8 ounces under third class matter, while amounts over the 8 ounces will be given zone rates. Merchandise under this classification is also given a rate of 8 ounces and under to be sent as third class material, while over the stipulated amount will be sent by zones.

Service charges are listed as 2 cents on each parcel except those originating on rural routes. Special handling charges are 25 cents for each parcel.

There are slight increases on the special charges for money orders, registered mail, insured articles, COD articles, and for special delivery.
