An expansion of the Friendly Relations committees of the Young Men's Christian and the Young Women's Christian associations, the investigation group is composed of 24 representatives of many welfare and denominational bodies. It is called the Commission Survey of Foreign Students in the United States and its labors in this field have taken three years.

The need for self-support has been no small factor in the lives of these young students from distant lands, the commission found, and many have taken back a sense of disillusionment as to America's ideals and practices. Some find that the Christianity acquired from American missionaries was not confirmed by the Christianity they met in the land which sent the missionaries forth.

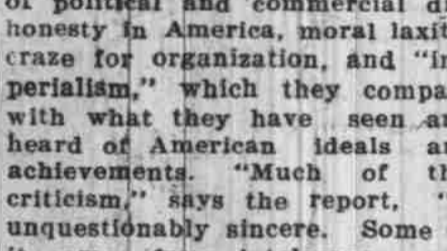

## Resenting Higher Prices Britons Boycott Whiskey

LONDON, April 18.—A whiskey rebellion is brewing in His Majesty's domains. The fact that one pays more for the legal purchase of a bottle of whiskey in British than for an illegally obtained in America, is too much for the Scotch distillers and the English consumers. Several visits to the chancellor of the exchequer and a boycott on spirits have been undertaken.

This dual effort has been unproductive. Chancellor Churchill is making no provision for a reduction of the excise tax in his coming budget and, although the home consumption of spirits has dropped 50 per cent, from 24,068,000 gallons in 1914 to 12,588,000 in 1924, the foreign demand has kept the vats filled and the distilleries wide open. About 29,000,000 gallons were distilled last year, against 1,600,000 gallons less than that amount in 1914.

The distiller and the consumer, who thus have been brought together, have organized a society with the object of telling their less interested countrymen of their grievances. The society is contemplating a nation-wide campaign for the reduction of the domestic revenue tax on spirits.

## Guards To Chase Bandits In Their Own Speed Boats

WASHINGTON, April 18.—The specially designed speed boats which have become common in the illegal delivery traffic between Rum Run and the coast, are to be pressed into service, whenever captured, in the war to enforce the blockade under regulations now being prepared in the treasury department.

Acting under authority of a statute enacted in the closing days of the 68th Congress, the department is preparing to utilize the authority therein conferred to use vessels and vehicles seized in the process of enforcing the Volstead act.

The new regulations are to be promulgated May 1. In the meantime the government will continue to offer at auction the carriers caught in the coastal and high way nets, but with stricter application of safeguards designed to prevent their purchase by former owners.

While recent figures are not available, the prohibition unit during the year ended June 30, 1924, seized over the country 5,214 automobiles having an estimated total value of \$3,226,339; and 236 boats and launches valued approximately at \$279,198. The coast guard, during the calendar year 1924, seized 251 vessels.
