Murdock Mystery Man Will Make Drive Blindfolded



Heavy Traffic Will Not Bother This Driver Although He Will Be Wearing a Blindfold.



Several Stops Will Be Made in the Business District.

All are invited to witness a Blindfold drive which will take place in Salem Tuesday noon. The Statesman has made arrangements with Mr. Murdock, who will be at the Bligh Theatre the first part of the week, to drive through the streets of Salem while blindfolded. A Moon touring car will be used for the drive. Mr. Delano of the Salem Automobile Company is furnishing the car and Frank Bligh, proprietor of the Bligh Theatre is giving his guarantee that the car will not be hurt in anyway.

Unless some changes in the drive are requested by Mr. Murdock the drive will be as follows. Starting in front of the Bligh Theatre, after the blindfold has been examined and placed on the drivers eyes, Murdock will drive west on State street to Al Krause's Men's Furnishing store, where he will stop. Then he will proceed west on State to Commercial to Court, then east on Court street to the Stiff Furniture Company, where he will make his second stop. He will continue east on Court to High street then south on High to the Ace Confectionery store and the Staples Optical Company. He will turn west on State to Liberty, then south on Liberty to the Grease Spot. Continuing south on High to Ferry, he will turn east to High street and then north on High to the Salem Automobile Company, where he will complete the drive.

Mr. Murdock is expected to arrive in Salem sometime today and if he wishes any changes in the routing of the drive mention of the change will be made in Tuesday's Statesman. The drive will start from the Bligh Theatre promptly at 11:50 and should be completed soon after 12 so that no one may miss their lunch.

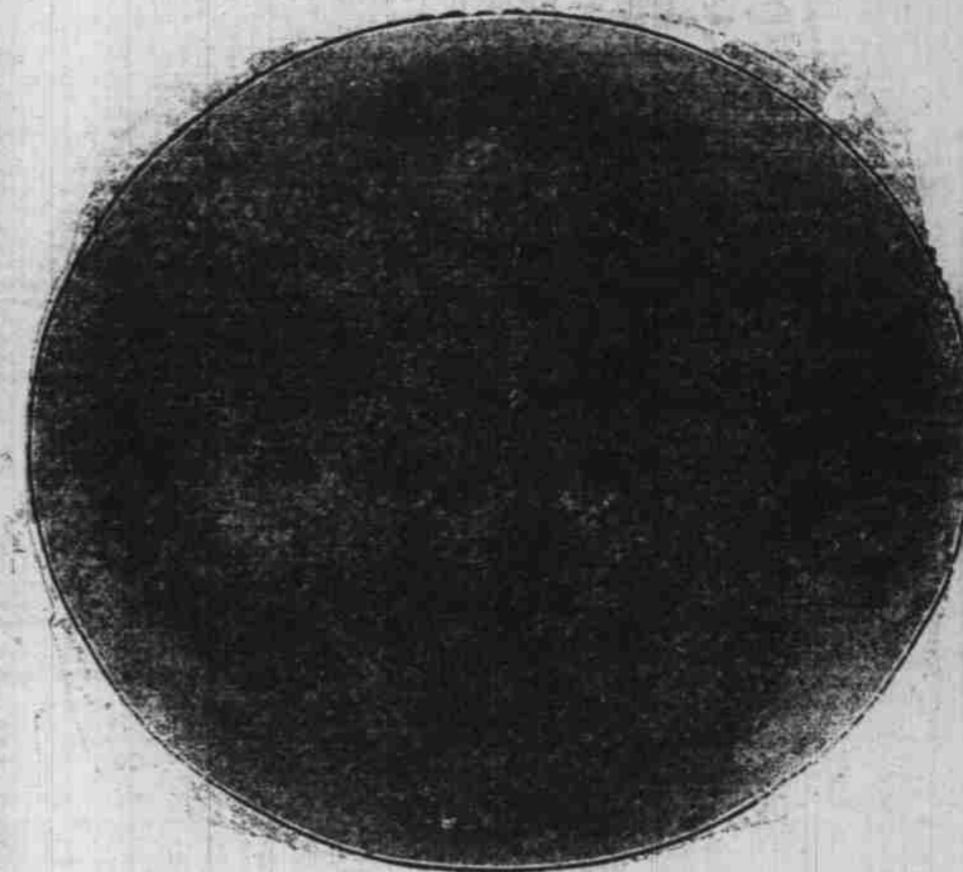
