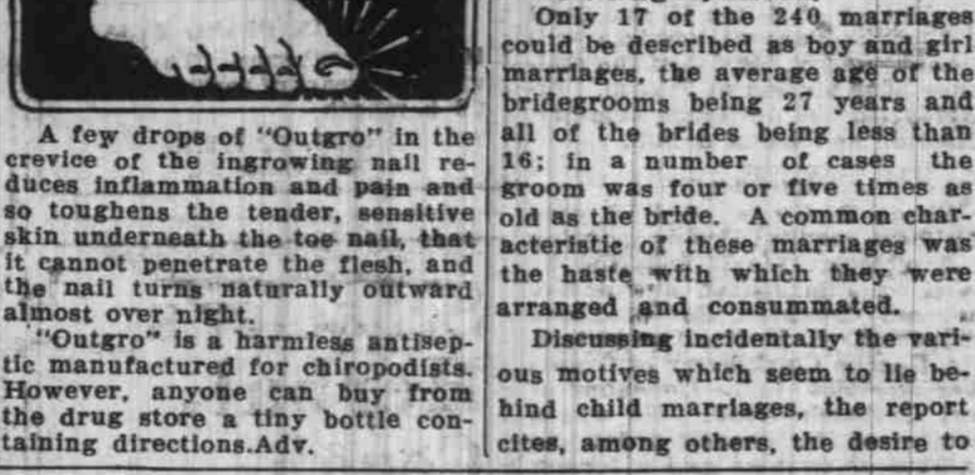
antle ideal," says the report, "that there is something idyllic about the marriage of a boy and a girl who have fallen in love with each other. But on nearer view the romance of child marriage vanishes. The outstanding fact with respect to the marriage of a girl under 16 and a boy under 18 is the physical and mental immaturity of these children."

The report shows that marriage at an early age is more frequent in small towns and rural districts than in large cities. The tendency to marry earlier in a warm climate than in a cold one is indicated throughout the world. Another important factor in this problem is the isolation of certain towns, villages, and rural districts where there are few means of intercommunication and inadequate recreational and educational facilities. To such conditions are attributable the early marriages of natives in the Appalachian Mountain chain, where a girl is considered a spinster at 18.

"In certain isolated American communities," says the report, "we still find not only very early marriages, but so many intermarriages among the cousins of one family strain that sometimes three-fourths of the inhabitants of a village have the same surname. Increased facilities of communication, however, by railroad, automobile, telephone, telegraph, and newspaper have come to mean not only a more varied food supply and greater cultural advantages; they also bring about a wider choice and, in all probability, a somewhat delayed and better choice of mates."

The Foundation's investigators found that, according to the United States census, the percentage of 15 to 19 year old girls who are married is lowest in New England, where it is exactly half of
