(Continued from page 10)
would produce enough acreage to get at least 10,000 acres for a factory. It is highly important that experiments be carried out to demonstrate and bring up to date the experiment started many years ago by the station to determine on the feasibility of growing sugar beets in western Oregon districts. If they can be produced it ought to prove an excellent cash crop and a source of beet by-products.
First One at Salem
(The above, by Prof. Hyslop, ought to prove to any one that we can produce the beets here in the Willamette valley; for later experiments carried on are making better showings on the average than the earlier experiments. The main reason why the first

factory should be located at Salem is because of the fact that we are in the habit of securing large numbers of seasonable workers here, in our bush and tree fruit orchards, hop yards, onion plantations, strawberry fields, etc. And we have at least as large bodies of suitable land as are found around any of the other valley cities.—Ed.)
